

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

#### A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOBE

Pax et bonum! (Peace and all good!)

This Sunday, as we set our sights on Easter, we are called to ask ourselves what our goals are for Lent and, ultimately, for life. In the second reading, St. Paul tells the Philippians and us that he considers everything as loss except for the supreme good and goal of knowing Christ; Christ is his real wealth. To realize that goal, St. Paul is willing to share in the sufferings of Christ by being conformed to His death. For our part, do we see the value, today, in suffering as a sharing in the redemptive suffering of Christ? Can we really have Christ without the cross?

Whatever our goal in life, the Lord pledges to help us along the way just as He did when He divided the Red Sea and guided the chosen people over chariots and charioteers to the Promised Land (1st Reading). Even when we sin and fall, like the adulteress in the Gospel, Jesus does not condemn her but, rather, forgives her and, assuredly, gives her a new lease on life.

It is interesting in the Gospel that the seniors are the first to realize and admit that they are sinners. Older and more mature in conscience, our elders can point us in the right direction along the path of life to our goal of being all united together in Christ. With thanksgiving, let us lift up our seniors and all those who help us on our own way to the Promised Land of Heaven.
