



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

PASTORAL COUNCIL'S Mission, Objectives and Roles

Parish Pastoral Council membership is a form of community service. Positions within the council indicate specific responsibilities that parishioners willingly commit themselves to having better opportunities to do ministry. Meanwhile, the nomination process indicates the free selection by participating community members and not a candidacy of person/s to any position of honor or power.

- 1. It is the primary leadership grouping, called from the parish community, to share with the Pastor to build up the body of Christ and to be concerned with the overall welfare of the parish family.
- **2.** It is a *consultative body* that **shares the responsibility** of <u>proclaiming the Word of God, building, and strengthening the Church Community, praying (personally and collectively), and <u>serving</u> others in charity.</u>
- **3.** To **discern** the spiritual and material needs of the parish community and **to plan, organize, and initiate** the implementation of structures required to fulfill these needs.
- 4. To work for a just society with other churches and organizations in the neighborhood and the broader community, in particular: (a) To be concerned with all the pastoral aspects of parish life, ensuring that parishioners are served well by the Parish and have meaningful opportunities to contribute to the parish ministries; (b) To consult with parishioners and parish groups and then represent them effectively in deliberations and decision-making that generally affect parish life. (c) provide consultative advice Pastor and help in identifying goals and setting up policies for the Parish while defining the means to achieve these goals; (d) monitor and evaluate the work of the various committees and ministries of the Parish, without becoming involved in the dayto-day details, and to act together as a council for the betterment of the Parish

From the PASTOR's OFFICE

Today, the FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER, we heard it proclaimed that JESUS is the gate through which we can enter in security (Gospel according to John 10:1-10). He is Lord and Christ (Acts of the Apostles 2:14, 36-41), our Shepherd (Psalm 23:1-6) whom we should follow.

Our opening prayer at MASS expressed <u>God's call</u> as leading us **to share in the joys of heaven** – to be <u>blessed with His Providence</u>, <u>to live a life of humility and trust in His Mercy when we miss the mark</u> (sin) despite our best efforts; <u>to have firm hope in times of physical illness great difficulties</u> or suffering because we know as St. Peter points out --- that those who believe and follow the HIM have returned to the shepherd and the guardian of souls **(1 Peter 2:20-25).**

These truths of Faith, stated above, are essential as the Catholic Church in Canada observed the WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATION this Sunday.

All Catholics are invited to reflect on the meaning of God's call and to pray for vocations. Christ, the GOOD SHEPHERD, continues to lead his people through his Bishops, priests, and Deacons and calls many [lay people] to follow Him in this way (cf Ordo, page 228).

"The LORD is my shepherd, he leads me in right paths... even though I walked through the dark valley, I fear no evil. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me. I shall dwell in the house of the LORD my whole life long."
