

# **PASTORAL CARE**

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

# Featured Saint of the Week

<u>St. Peter Julian Eymard, Priest (August 2)</u>

Born in La Mure, France, St. Peter (1811-1868) became a priest in 1835 and joined the Marist in 1840. He fostered Eucharistic Adoration and founded a religious order of priest-adorers of the Holy Eucharist, the Priests of the Blessed Sacrament.

### A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

#### Peace, Joy, and blessings!

My dear brothers and sisters, the solemnity of the Assumption of our Lady to heaven is fast approaching. This year we will be celebrating the 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the foundation of the Parish. Let us remember the toil of those people who tirelessly gave their service and resources to gather the people of God. They are the real foundation of this parish. As we see in the first reading today the journey of the Israelites into the promised land, hardship made the people complain with Moses and God. I am sure the Parish's journey for 90 years is not easy too. Like the Israelites, there have been some quarrels, complaints, hardships and pains. But God's grace kept the parish united and strong. Jesus fed us with Himself in the Eucharist.

Jesus in today's Gospel reminds us not to work for food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life. St. Paul in his letter to the Romans said: "the kingdom of God does not mean food and drink but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit".

Our only joy is the Eucharist, for it is the source and summit of our life. Knowing and encountering Jesus in the Eucharist sustains us in this our pilgrimage on earth. It is the food that last forever. When we have Jesus, our pains, suffering and experience of rejection is transformed into perfect joy.

Mary tells us to do whatever Jesus, her Son, tells us to do. In preparation for this great event, we will be having Novena Masses starting on August 6, feast of the Transfiguration, until August 14, feast of St. Maximillian Kolbe. The theme for this 9-day Novena will be taken from the Hail Mary prayer. Listening to Mary, our mother will bring us closer to Jesus, her Son.

Let us prepare ourselves for this wonderful event by trying to discern and follow the will of God.
