# STEWARDSHIP: A beautiful word by Fr. Maurice Dionne

At a first glance, to think of your Christian life as stewardship does not seem particularly inspiring. Dictionaries define stewardship as being the manager of someone else's property. This word has a lot of administrative connotations that don't make you soar like an eagle. But if that someone else is God and the property is your life and everything it contains or is connected to, things begin to flow. You're entering the spirituality of stewardship: managing your life for God. Your relationship to God is expressed in how you manage the parameters of your life, or what stewardship would designate as the manifold gifts God has bestowed upon you. Gift is a very important word in stewardship. We are called to the realization that all is gift. These gifts are grouped into three categories: time or the basic thread of your existence, talent or what makes you specifically you, and treasure, the resources of all kinds that you have at your disposal. A Christian steward, one who commits himself to following Jesus, manages these gifts in the following manner: receives them gratefully, nurtures them responsibly, shares them justly and charitably, and returns them to God abundantly.

A Christian steward then seeks to dwell in thanksgiving; to be responsible, generous and fruitful. All these require further explanation and thoughtful consideration, but the key is *gratitude*. An attitude of gratitude is the foundation of a steward's *management style*. Are you curious to learn more? Our website **www.ottawacatholicstewardship.ca** provides additional information. My hope is that as individuals, parishes, and as an archdiocese, we would come to understand this calling and live it out more.
