

### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**SPIRITUAL COUNSELING** - By appointment.

# SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

### Featured Saint of the Week

Blessed Michael McGivney (August 13)

The eldest son of an immigrant Irish family in Connecticut. At 16 he began studies for the priesthood in Quebec. He completed his education in Baltimore, Maryland, and was ordained for the diocese of Hartford in 1877.

Assigned to St. Mary's Parish in New Haven, Fr. McGivney was very active in parish and civic affairs. He volunteered to become the guardian of Alfred Downes, a minor whose father had died leaving a large family in poverty. This situation as well as his own family's circumstances and that of other immigrants impressed on Fr. McGivney the need for lay Catholic men to establish a mutual aid society to provide financial assistance for their families if the primary wage earner died.

In 1882, Fr. McGivney formed the Knights of Columbus among a small group of St. Mary's parishioners to promote charity, unity, and fraternity, assisting widows and orphans. Because of the Knights' emphasis on serving Church, community and family, the organization grew and did not remain strictly parish based. Patriotism was added as a founding principle in 1900. Father McGivney died from pneumonia in 1890 and was buried in Thomaston, Connecticut. Later his body was moved back to St. Mary's in New Haven where it remains today. He was beatified in 2020.

### <u>A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR</u>

This day, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the BVM into heaven, marks the 90th year of the foundation of our beloved parish. We praise God who has taken the sinless Virgin Mary, body, and soul, into his glory.

In the first reading, we find the Ark of the Covenant, that has been missing since the Temple destruction, in the temple of God in the heaven. In the Gospel of St. Luke, the Ark of the Covenant is a symbol that becomes a reality in Mary, who does not only contain the symbols of the function of Christ (Staff, as King; Tablet of the 10 commandments, as Prophet; & Manna as Priest), but Jesus. St. Augustine says that even before the Word entered the womb of Mary, He was already there at the heart of Mary.

Of her, we sing to God: "The queen stands at your right hand, arrayed in gold." And as Bathsheba takes her place at the right hand of Solomon, her son and king, God puts Mary on a place prepared for her, at the right side of the King of Kings, her Son Jesus, our Lord Peace, Joy, & Blessings to you!
