

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

Saint of the Week

St. Pius X, Pope (August 21)

Born near Venice, St. Pius X (1835-1914), was known for his service to all members of the Church as a priest, bishop, Patriarch of Venice and Pope. He defended the purity of the Catholic doctrine against modern and resurgent heresies and was instrumental in extending the practice of frequent reception of Holy Communion.

A Message from the Pastor

Ave María Puríssíma!

Today, we reflect on the mystery of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven, the titular of our parish.

It is with great joy that our parish joins the whole Christendom in thanking God for the gift of this great woman, the mother of Jesus and our mother too. Her assumption into heaven, body and soul was solemnly proclaimed a dogma of the Church by Pope Píus XII in November 1, 1950. Devastated by war, the Pope gave this truth to the Church to look beyond the miseries of human life and invites all to fix their gaze on Mary, assumed by God into heaven. The Church reiterates the truth that this life's misery is just momentary and that we should continue our lives with hope and with the joy of knowing that Jesus had already won the victory and that together with our mother, Mary, we will share in the inheritance of heaven prepared for us. As our títular and patron, Mary stands as our model ín following Jesus, our Saviour. She who opened the human world for God, the praying and listening woman.

She is a mother who continue to ask us to open our hearts to the Father, to listen to the Word of God made flesh, her son Jesus, and to allow the Holy Spirit to transform our lives to be able to reacquire the image and likeness of the Holy Trinity.
