

BRÉBEUF – a gentle and holy giant by Archbishop Prendergast

St. John de Brébeuf (1593-1649) was the first Jesuit missionary in Huronia (1626) and a master of the native language. He founded mission outposts, converted thousands to the faith and inspired many Jesuits to volunteer for the missions of New France. Massive in body, gentle in character, with the heart of a giant, he was known as the apostle of the Hurons. The Indians thought he was too large for the canoe, but he was accepted on condition that he sat in the canoe absolutely still. On the trip from Quebec to Huronia, he helped whatever way he could. The Hurons named him "Echon", the load-bearer.

Brébeuf worked hard and learned to respect the Wendat/Huron people, producing a dictionary of their language and adapting the story of the Christian faith in terms they could understand. Jesu Ahatonhia (Jesus is born) is the first Canadian Christmas carol; it speaks of Jesus born in a "lodge of broken bark" and wrapped in a "robe of rabbit skin". The Christ Child is surrounded by hunters instead of shepherds, and the Magi are portrayed as "chiefs from afar" that bring him "fox and beaver pelts" instead of the more familiar gold, frankincense, and myrrh. With other Jesuit novices, I learned the vision that Brébeuf drew upon in his prayer from the Spiritual Exercises. From conferences, I came to admire the Canadian Martyrs, particularly Brébeuf. His spiritual development led him to vow in 1631 to serve Christ to the point of martyrdom. "Jesus Christ is our true greatness", he wrote in 1635, "it is him alone and his cross that one should seek among these people". Brébeuf suffered a cruel death in 1649. With seven other martyrs of the Canadian Mission, he was canonized in 1930.
