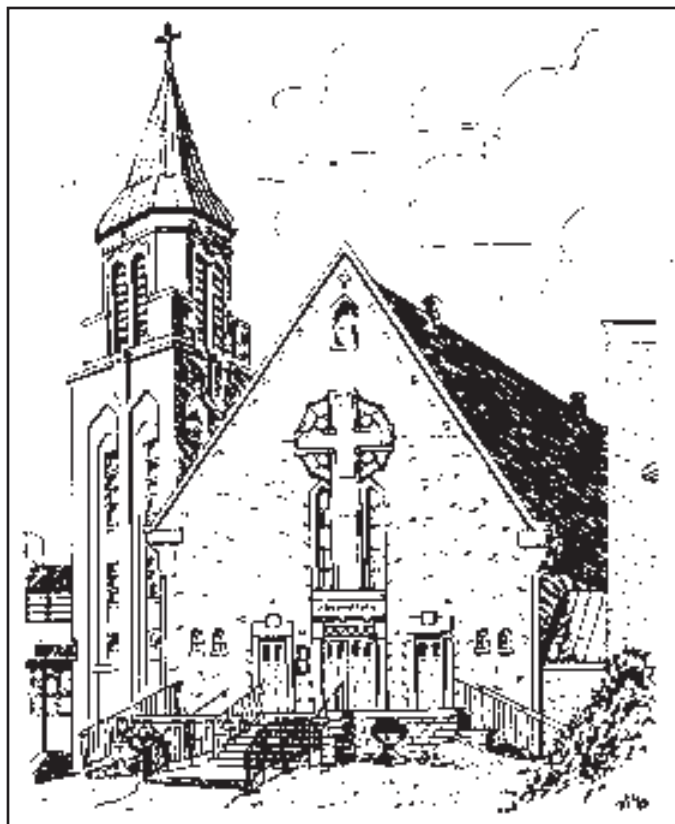

TRAINING FOR NEW LECTORS: We are planning to provide training for new lectors in the fall. In accordance to the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be *"truly suited"* (GIRM 101). This means that the person should be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church, should not be living in an invalid marriage (CCL 1055.1.1, 1056) or in any other state of grave sin (CCL 915, 209.1) and have the ability to read and clearly speak in the language that they are to proclaim the Word of God.
