“Journeying Through the Adult Stages of Life”

Sept 28- 30, 2012 Healing and recovery involve not only healing our inner child, but also developing & strengthening our adult. The fastest growing recovery programs (e.g. Codependents Anonymous) and major treatment centers are now emphasizing adult development. But if we have grown up in a dysfunctional family we may not have had models of healthy adults. The psychologist Erik Erikson says adults will remain a child unless they can answer four questions: Who am I? How am I to be intimate with another? What life generating work am I called to do? What is the special meaning of my life? This retreat will help develop our adult strengths, heal our hurts, and move into a fully adult relationship with God making maturity possible.

Matthew Linn, SJ has focused on integrating physical, emotional, and spiritual healing. Since 1970 he has taught courses & given retreats on healing in over 50 countries and has co-author 21 books translated in over 20 languages.
