

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

A Message from Your Pastor

Pax et bonum.

Today's readings are the last of the four-series meditative theme about the Holy Eucharist.

After the long exposition of the Eucharist, we are asked to make our choice like that of the Israelites in the first reading and that of the Apostles in the Gospel. It is either to believe in the Eucharist and serve our God or to believe in and serve false gods.

For four weeks we have been shown in the liturgy the mystery of the Eucharist—a miracle far greater than those performed by God in bringing the Israelites out of the land of Egypt.

God has promised us a new homeland and eternal life, offering us bread from heaven to strengthen us on our journey. He has told us that unless we eat His Flesh and drink His Blood we will have no life in us.

It is a difficult teaching, but He has given us the words of eternal life. We have to believe; because, as Peter says today, "He is the Holy One of God", who handed himself over for us, who gave His flesh for the life of the world.

Let us renew our love for Jesus today, approaching his holy altar with confidence, as we sing in today's psalm, the Lord will redeem the lives of His servants.


