

## SOCIAL NETWORKING IN THE CHURCH OF TODAY

Physical distance that once limited our dialogue with others no longer does because new technologies allow us to "meet" in the virtual world. This is a great opportunity for the laity, and for members of religious communities and the clergy, including Archbishop Terrence Prendergast. In Canada, most people surf Facebook and YouTube, and a large number of people are on Twitter and LinkedIn. Some also write blogs and greatly influence their readers. Since 2009, Archbishop Prendergast spends 30 to 45 minutes per day writing his blog entitled The Journey of a Bishop. He felt that a blog was an effective way to reach young people. Statistics from the beginning of 2011 show that, on a monthly basis, nearly 14,000 unique visitors read his blog - an increase of 4,000 visitors per month compared to the beginning of 2010. He welcomes feedback, but deletes disrespectful posts. More recently, the Archbishop created a profile on Facebook last winter and he already has about 800 friends. Although he mainly posts comments on religious events, he shares a bit about his private life. For example, in February, he thanked those who wished him a happy birthday and he posted a picture of his birthday cake that he shared with his sister, Marion in Florida
