

ASSUMPTION PARISH NEWS

REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

The Rectory and Church courtyard lawn had its newly seeded grass cut for the first time and is looking good. The heavy rain has not penetrated the church walls facing this yard, so that part of the leaky basement problem is resolved.

As well, the electrical wiring is complete and we can now have lights as needed, and we can use new power outlets. The front of church lower wall has been re-pointed. It was a source of water seepage. Work is in progress on the Convent (Catholic Family Service) courtyard to eliminate the basement water leak from that side.

The current excavation work is on the northeast side outside, and inside the church for a new sump pump to connect the collected water seepage to the drainage. The sump pump pipe output connects to the public washroom drain underneath the main floor of the church. A broken drainpipe was discovered below the concrete floor in the northeast basement, below the front stairs, and this has to be fixed as well. Contact: Ed Hiscoe/Bob Scharf

CHURCH BOILER UPGRADE PROJECT

The old boiler is gone. Two smaller new boilers are scheduled on site by end of August, 2009. Our contractor C G Plumbing has already installed new pipes in the boiler room. The work schedule is on track. Contact: Mel Tabalba

PRE-AUTHORIZED DEBIT (PAD)

We thank many parishioners for starting their contribution using this method. The method is flexible. You can have more than one PAD for splitting your contributions. As an example, have one PAD to donate \$X every 15th of each month to go straight to COLLECTIONS, and a second PAD \$Y on each 28th of each month to go to BOILER ROOM. In this second case, the Archdiocese will not tax the contribution. A third PAD \$Z can be deducted quarterly to donate to the RESERVE FUND, again non-taxable till 2010. COUNTING WEEKLY COLLECTIONS

To relieve effort and save time, we will introduce a coin counting and sorting machine; and, a bill counting machine. In a practice run with Ed and Gloria Piol for last week's collection, it took about 2 hours from start to finish and to ready the bag for the bank deposit. Coins worth \$85 were counted within 50 seconds. The machine also puts the coins into the coin tubes. Next test run will include the use of the bill counting machine, and we expect to save some more time. The use of PAD will also reduce the time to count and record cheques. Contact: Mel Tabalba
