

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

A Message from the Pastor

Peace and all goodness!

We continue reflecting on the Holy Eucharist this Sunday. The first reading gives us the story of the Israelites, the people whom God love so much. God journeyed with them in the desert and fed them both physically and spiritually.

In their stubbornness, God showed them His marvelous deeds. In the second reading, Paul reminds the Ephesians that true encounter with Jesus, entails changing their lives. Leaving the old self and letting themselves to be renewed by Jesus. In the Eucharist, we encounter the same Jesus whom St. Paul encountered.

In the Gospel, Jesus invites them to go deeper in their search for Him. What other evangelists would see as miracles, John would call it as "signs". For John, miracles are not the end itself, it leads us to see beyond what the eye can see. These signs point towards the inner reality.

As we celebrate the Eucharist with Jesus, leading us to the Father through the Church, we are presented with the greatest sign that points back to Him. The Eucharist is the source and summit of every Christian life.


