

From the PASTOR'S OFFICE

We have steadfast HOPE, made strong by the fulfilled promise of the Coming of Jesus in history. As it is written: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

We made every effort to be in PEACE through harmoniously living with one another --- one of the many fruits of true repentance (**cf. Matthew 3:8**).

Staying alert not to succumb to the demand of life's concerns, always giving importance to what nourishes our souls, we can therefore REJOICE always for every good gift we receive and the Lord's gift of himself (**cf. Philippians 4:4**).

On this 4th Sunday of Advent, the readings point us to the sign given by God: "A young woman is with child and shall bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel" (Isaiah 17:14).
