CHRISTMAS MESSAGE 2014: My dear brothers and sisters in Christ: The Christmas season conveys biblical images that show us how we can become happy, healthy, and holy families. The feast of the Holy Family places young and old in close proximity. It invites us to reflect on the sacredness of life from conception to death. This fall, while in Rome, I was privileged to concelebrate Mass with Pope Francis. We met afterwards. This was just before the Synod on the Family, to which Pope Francis had invited bishops from around the world. They assembled to address the challenge of our time: the crisis of the family. Pope Francis recently said that the Christian family and marriage are under attack. You see, God wrote his plan of marriage into human nature and Christ raised it to be a sacrament. Society is replacing this view with the notion that people can bend intimate life to their own ideas and desires. The first Christians showed great courage in overcoming and transforming a vast, pagan world that had beliefs about marriage and sexual morality similar to those of our culture. Today, we again need God's grace and supernatural courage to publicly live out the Church's teaching on marriage, the family, and human sexuality. Our Church around the world will reflect on this in the coming year. Bishops and other Catholic leaders prepare for a second synod to consider how the Church and society can renew their commitment to the family. Saint Luke tells us of a profound encounter between the child Jesus and an elderly couple in the Jerusalem Temple. Jesus brought deep joy and consolation to the hearts of many who celebrated his birth. Once they had met Jesus, the elderly Simeon and Anna felt a sense of completion in their lives. Anna illustrates the truth that once you have encountered Jesus, you cannot help but tell others about him: "She came, and began to speak to all who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem." This is how Pope Francis encourages us to be missionary-disciples. Learn from Jesus. Live out his message. Share it with others. This Christmas season, may you and your family come to know the Holy Family better and learn how to make your homes places of conversation, laughter and joy! Christmas is a time for family sharing. If you've become disconnected from the Church, I invite you to come back home. We miss you. Bring your contribution to the Church family's conversation, and help us be a better Church.
