Born in Bethsaida, the fisherman, St. John was called to follow Christ shile mending his nets. He wrote a Gospel, three Epistles and the Book of Revelation. With his brother, St. James and St. Peter, St. John witnessed the Transfiguration. At the Last Supper, this "beloved disciple" leaned on Our Lord's breast and at the foot of the Cross, Christ entrusted His own Mother to His care. St. John's purity kept him close to Christ. He was exiled to the island of Patmos under Emperor Domitian.
