# MERRY CARISTMAS!

After four weeks of preparation, during which we reflected on the themes of HOPE, PEACE, JOY, and FAITH on each Sunday of the Season of Advent --- we begin the CHRISTMAS TIME.

We gather at the Solemn MASSES of the evening of December 24th at the VIGIL liturgy; we express confidently that the LORD shall come, he will save us, and then we will see His glory (*cf. Exodus 16:6-7*).

In the person of JESUS, we see that GOD CARES. <u>God is faithful to His promise, he saved</u> <u>his People, and he continues to do so not only for</u> <u>them who he chose first but also for all</u> who listen to Jesus' teaching, accept its guidance and directions, and put them into practice.
