SAINT OF THE WEEK

Sts. Basil the Great & Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops and Doctors of the Church (January 2nd)

St. Basil (329-379) was a brilliant student born of a Christian family in Caesarea, Cappadocia (Modern day Turkey). He fought the Arian heresy vigorously. He followed the monastic way of life before being elected Archbishop of Caesarea in 370. Monks of the Eastern Rites still follow the monastic rule he wrote. St. Gregory (329-389) was also from Cappadocia. A friend of St. Basil, he also followed the monastic way of life before being elected Archbishop of Constantinople in 381, in which capacity he fought against the Arian heresy at its height. He is called "The Theologian" because of his great learning and talent for oratory.
