

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

The first reading and the Gospel this Sunday present to us a picture of an authentic encounter with God. Both the prophet Isaiah and St. Peter felt and recognized their sinfulness and inadequacy to the calling when they experience God.

The more we know and encounter the person of Jesus, the more we will see clearly the truth of our soul's condition. We will surely realize our sinfulness. We often hear the saints saying that they are the greatest of all sinners. However, looking at their life we see only their holiness. They are able to see their sinfulness because they are shown the purity of their Master, Jesus.

This Sunday, the Church asks us to reflect on our life.

If we cannot see our sinfulness, it might be because our encounter with the Lord is not authentic. Maybe our eyes are clouded; that is why we cannot see clearly. Maybe our ears are blocked from hearing the Master's voice. We have to purify our hearts and take away all blockages so that we may see clearly and hear distinctly.

Let us allow ourselves to be purified by entering into the immaculate heart of Mary; that we may be reborn cleansed of all impurities and that we may hear her voice that says: "Do whatever my Son tells you to do!"
