

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Conrad of Piacenza, Hermit (February 19)

Conrad was born in Piacenza. Following an accident that occurred while he was hunting, he sold all his possessions and he and his wife forsook the world. After joining the Third Order of St. Francis he went to Sicily where he lived a very austere life for almost forty years. He died in the year 1351.

<u>A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR</u>

Peace and blessings my dear brothers and sisters in Christ!

Departing from the theme of last Sunday: "God has come to take his people by the hand to raise them up." We see now Jesus continuing that work of raising the fallen humanity. He does that by cleansing us of our impurities of body and soul.

In the first reading, we see how the Israelites view leprosy: an impurity that makes one a living dead. In fact Moses asked the lepers to wear torn clothes, shave their heads, cover their upper lip and shout. An act we see done by one mourning over a death of a loved one. In the Old Testament, we see some prophets cleansing the lepers by asking them to wash or bathe in a pool to indicate that God has sent His prophet to His people.

The Gospel for this Sunday presents Jesus as more than a prophet. There is no need of bathing in a pool for He is the living water that cleanses and nourishes life. His "Word" is enough to cleanse us from our iniquities. Just like in the book of Genesis, when God spoke, it came to be. Only God can cure leprosy and cleanse us from sin, and only God has the power to bring about what He wills.

Again, we see Jesus stretching out His hands, a gesture very symbolical, like in the Old Testament when God stretched out His hands and performed wondrous deeds to save the Israelites from slavery from the Egyptians.

The Psalmist invites us all to take refuge in the Lord. To go to Him to be cleansed from our impurities so that the fullness of life might come to us. For life flows when we are in Christ, apart from Jesus, there is only death.
