

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and Joy!

This week, Jesus tells us in the Gospel that His coming is not to abolish the "Law" but to fulfill it. Jesus came to teach us the heart of the Law and to give us an example how to fulfill it.

The outward observant of the Law is not enough because it remains on the surface and does not sink deeply into our hearts. Jesus rewrites the Law not anymore on a tablet of stone but on the heart of each and everyone. The law of Love that Jesus inscribe in our hearts wounds us but it opens our heart to receive the love of God that God might be our strength to be able to love our neighbour.

Jesus' own heart was not spared from that wound. It was not wounded to receive love for He Himself is the source of love but it was wounded to show us that the "Ocean of Mercy" is gushing forth from His wounded heart.

The heart is the seat of our motivations, the place from which our words and actions proceed.

Jesus calls us to master our hearts, to conquer our passions and emotions. Jesus demands the full obedience of our hearts. He calls us to love God with all our hearts, and to do His will from the heart.

When God ask of us, he gives us also the capacity to do it but it is up to us to choose life over death, to choose goodness over the fires of ungodliness and sin.
