

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life

St. John Paul II established the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life in 1997 to be celebrated in conjunction with the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas Day, which highlights the fact that Christ is the light of the world through the symbolic lighting of candles. "Similarly, consecrated men and women are called to spread the light and love of Jesus Christ through their unique witness of selfless service, such as caring for the poor, the contemplative work of prayer, or through their professional careers." It is also an invitation for all to rediscover the beauty of consecrated life as a gift to the Church and the world.

This 1st of February 2025 at 5:00 PM in Rome, Pope Francis will preside over Vespers at St. Peter's Basilica. The event is part of the celebrations for the **29th World Day for Consecrated Life**, an opportunity for gratitude and renewal for all consecrated men and women. The Jubilee of Consecrated Life will be on October 8 & 9, 2025.
