

# PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**SPIRITUAL COUNSELING** - by appointment.

# SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

**FUNERALS** - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

<u>St. Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows, Religious</u> (February 27)

Born in Italy (March 1, 1838 – February 27, 1862) into a large family and baptized Francis, lost his mother when he was four. He entered the Passionist at a young age and was given the name Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows. He quickly advanced in prayer and love of the poor. After four years in religious life, he got sick with tuberculosis. He accepted it and bore the pain patiently. He died peacefully on February 27, 1862, at age 24, having been an example to both young and old. He was canonized in 1920.

#### Peace and Joy!

Holy Mother Church continues to guide and feed us with the Word of God. Jesus in today's Gospel reminds us of our goal to be holy for our Father in heaven is holy. We are destined to heaven and for that we have to strive to be like our heavenly Father. Jesus is showing us the way on how to be with His Father: by becoming imitators of God who is love.

As God showed us, we must love without limit with a love that does not distinguish between friend and enemy, overcoming evil with good.

In His Passion and death, Jesus himself, gave us the perfect example of the love that we are called to.

He offered no resistance to the evil—even though He could have commanded twelve legions of angels to fight alongside Him. He offered His face to be struck and spit upon, His head to be crowned with thorns. He allowed His garments to be stripped from Him, and His body to be nailed on the cross. He marched as His enemies compelled Him to the Place of the Skull. On the cross He prayed for those who persecuted Him. We have been bought with the price of the blood of God's only Son. We do not anymore belong to Satan, we belong to Christ now, as St. Paul says in this week's Epistle. By our baptism, we have been made temples of His Holy Spirit.
