



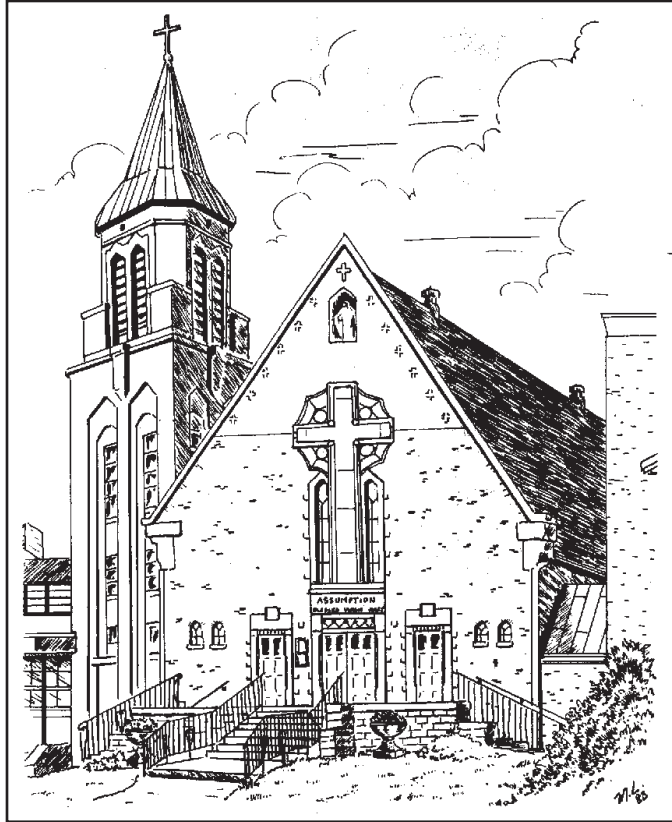

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows

Born Francesco Possenti, (March 1, 1838 – Feb. 27, 1862), was an Italian Passionist clerical student. Born to a professional family, he gave up ambitions of a secular career to enter the Passionist Congregation. His life in the monastery was not extraordinary, yet he followed the rule of the congregation perfectly and was known for his great devotion to the sorrows of the Virgin Mary. He died from tuberculosis at the age of 23 in Isola del Gran Sasso, in the province of Teramo. He was canonized by Pope Benedict XV in 1920.

Message from the Pastor

Peace and Goodness!

The readings for the second Sunday of Lent presents us with another test. Last Sunday was the temptation of Jesus in the desert. In today's first reading, Abraham's faith was put into test by God. He was asked to offer his beloved son. He was promised children more numerous as the stars of heaven and here he is old, his only son asked to be offered.

In the second reading, St. Paul used the same words drawn from this story to show how God, like Abraham, did not withhold His only Son, but instead handed Him over for us on the Cross.

In the gospel too, we hear another echo. As Isaac is described as Abraham's beloved firstborn son, Jesus is called God's "beloved Son". These readings are presented to us during Lent to reveal Christ's identity and to strengthen us in the face of our temptations and afflictions.

In His transfiguration, Jesus is revealed to be the "prophet like Moses" foretold by God and raised from among their own people, speaking with God's own authority and the fulfillment of the Law. His resurrection should give us the strength to face our own difficulties, to be able to give ourselves totally to the Father as He did, as Abraham and Isaac did.

Saved from death by His death, we present ourselves in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass to offer through Him, in Him, and with Him the sacrifice of thanksgiving.
