

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

<u>Featured Saint of the Week</u> Blessed Agnes of Prague, Virgin (March 2)

Agnes, daughter of Premislaus, king of Bohemia, was born in Prague about the year 1205. She declined an imperial marriage and in 1236 entered the monastery of the Poor Clares that she had founded and which she directed for many years. She enjoyed a close friendship with St. Clare who wrote several letters to her dealing with Franciscan spirituality. Agnes died between the years 1280-1283.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Peace and Joy!

We have the saying that says: The fish is caught with his mouth. Jesus in the Gospel this Sunday tells us that "it is from the abundance of the heart that the mouth speaks." We will know the person from the words that he/she speaks. A heart full of love will speak with love, a heart full of hatred will speak with hatred.

Last Monday, we heard about Jesus healing a person possessed by a mute and deaf spirit. The possession made the person not only physically impaired but also spiritually impaired. The possession of the evil one hampers a person to hear the Word of God and because of this he is unable to speak the Word of God too. We can only give what we receive. When we listen to the voice of the Lord, our hearts become impregnated with the Word of God, it transforms us and will manifest in the words that we speak and the manner of life we live.

Sirach in the first reading teaches us that speaking is the test of men. One who is upright will utter words that are truthful but one whose heart is cluttered with refuse will be disclosed.

Jesus reminds us: by your word, you will be justified, and by your word you will be condemned.

Let us purify our hearts and train our tongue that we may speak only of the love and compassion of God.
