TRAINING FOR EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS AT ASSUMPTION PARISH

Is God calling you to serve Him as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) at Mass or to carry the Body of Christ (Viaticum) to the sick or shut-ins? Maybe you feel called to proclaim God's Word at Mass as a Lector? In accordance to the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be "truly suited". This means that the person must be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin. Being "truly suited" in the case of Lectors, also implies the necessary abilities to read in the language of the specific Mass to be able to proclaim the readings in a clear manner that expresses the dignity of scripture.

The second requirement of the Church is that EHMC's and Lector's "Should receive careful preparation" and be commissioned in these Holy Ministries. We are in the process of planning training sessions for EHMC's and Lectors. In order to do so we need to find out how many people feel that God is calling them and in faith are willing to respond to Him. If you wish to serve the Lord in these special Ministries, simply call the office indicating which Ministry you feel called to, leave your name and phone number or you may wish to send an e-mail to Deacon Paul at beaudp@rogers.com.
