

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

<u>A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR</u>

Peace, health, and blessings!

With the devastation that Covid-19 is bringing to the world, we relate more with the lamentation of Job in the first reading. Job describes the futility of our life. It brings us back to the book of Genesis with the curse of toil, hardship, and death inherited by Adam because of sin. The terrible enslavement to sin and its consequences. But the promise of the Messiah gives the psalmist hope, and he invites us to: "Sing praises to the lord who heals the broken hearted."

That promise of the Messiah is seen alive and accomplished in the Gospel today. Simon's mother-in-law is like toiling, hopeless humanity. She is laid low by affliction but too weak to save herself.

As God promised to take his people by the hand, so Jesus took her by the hand and lifted her up. With this pandemic, we are like her, afflicted and weak. We cannot stand on our own but Jesus offers to take us by our hands and lift us up.

God would never give up on us unless we ourselves has given up on Him. He sent His only begotten Son to redeem the world and to show them the way back to Him through Love. Paul, in following the Lord says: "To the weak, I became weak, so that I might win the weak. I have become all things to all people, that I might by all means save some."

Let us learn from the readings this Sunday and try to follow the way of the Lord, the way of love, which gives us hope strengthened by our faith, the faith of the Church.
