NEW AUXILIARY BISHOP FOR OTTAWA:

In response to a request made by the Most Reverend Terrence Prendergast, SJ, Archbishop of Ottawa, His Holiness Pope Francis announced this week that he has appointed **Fr. Christian Riesbeck, CC** to the position of **Auxiliary Bishop of Ottawa**. Until his appointment, Bishop-elect Riesbeck was Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Ottawa and Assistant General Superior of the Companions of the Cross – a priestly Society of Apostolic Life founded in Ottawa. In his new role, Bishop-elect Riesbeck will assist Archbishop Prendergast in shepherding some 400 000 Catholics in 110 parishes in Canada's capital and Eastern Ontario. Ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop Marcel Gervais as a member of the Companions of the Cross at Notre Dame Cathedral on October 12, 1996, he served for brief periods between 1996 and 1999 at Our Lady of Lourdes parish in Kingston, St. Jude's in Hawkesbury, Our Lady of Divine Love in Pendleton and St. Francis Xavier in Brockville before becoming pastor of Queen of Peace parish in Houston, Texas (1999-2008).

APPOINTMENT OF APOSTOLIC NUNCIO TO CANADA: The Holy Father has appointed **Archbishop Luigi Bonazzi** as Apostolic Nuncio to Canada.
