Introduction to the Nicene Creed - Part Twelve.

This week we look at the Second Coming of Christ: "HE WILL COME AGAIN IN GLORY TO JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD AND HIS KINGDOM WILL HAVE NO END." We celebrate the First Coming of Christ in his humility as a baby at Christmas in the Mystery of the Incarnation. We look forward to his Second Coming when he returns to earth in glory. At that time, *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches us: "when he comes at the end of time to judge the living and the dead, the glorious Christ will reveal the secret disposition of hearts and will render to each man according to his works, and according to his acceptance or refusal of grace" (n. 682). Sometimes we gloss over Jesus Christ's judgment and take for granted that all will be saved but the Creed speaks of Christ's 'judging' the living and the dead. Our actions here in this life have real consequences for eternity in the Kingdom of God.
