



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.



This Second Sunday of Ordinary Time, we listen to John the Baptist, who, when he sees Jesus passing by, points Him out to his disciples, saying, "Behold, the Lamb of God!" (John 1:36).

John the Baptist recognizes Jesus as the longawaited Messiah, the one who will take away the sins of the world. He invites his disciples to shift their focus from himself to Jesus, acknowledging that Jesus is the one they should follow.

Upon hearing this, two of John's disciples decide to follow Jesus. They begin to walk behind Him, and Jesus turns to them and asks, "What are you looking for?" (John 1:38). This question was directed at those two disciples and each of us. What are we seeking in our lives and the deepest desire of our hearts?

Like the apostles, **Jesus calls us to "come and see" (John 1:39)** -- to encounter Him personally and have a relationship with Him. We must focus deep into ourselves, seeking Him with all our hearts. Then, by His grace and our cooperation – when we listen to God's inspiration and follow his direction willfully --- Jesus shall transform us into His faithful disciples.

GOD calls and leads us. May we respond wholeheartedly to the call of Jesus. May the words of Scripture and the disciples' example inspire us to deepen our relationship with Christ and live out our faith with joy and conviction. Let us always remember that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life and that through Him, we can find true fulfillment and eternal life.
