

## PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SAINT OF THE WEEK Our Lady of Guadalupe (Feast-Queen of the St. Francis de Sales, Bishop & Doctor of the Church (January 24)Born in Thorens, Savoy, France, St Francis (1567-1622) was Bishop of Geneva, where he fought Calvinism vigorously. With St. Jane Frances de Chantal, he founded the Order of the Visitation. He wrote the classic Introduction to the Devout Life.He died in Lyons and was canonized in 1665. In 1877 Pope Bl. Pius IX proclaimed him a Doctor of the Church and patron saint of journalists and other writers.

## A Message from Your Pastor Come Lord Jesus and hasten your coming!

The feast of the epiphany (God manifesting/revealing himself to us) sets the theme for the ordinary time. As we begin the season of ordinary time, the Church, the bride of Christ, the bridegroom, slowly unveils to us the Trinity. And as she unveils it to us, she nourishes us also with the spiritual food, the Eucharist, for us to be united to Christ.

After the season of Christmas, the liturgy presents to us the sacrament of Baptism, today, the liturgy gives us the sacrament of Marriage. Baptism makes us children of our loving Father, Matrimony calls us to be one with him as members of the Church wedded to Christ.

The Bible begins and ends with wedding. Throughout the Bible, marriage is the symbol of the covenant relationship God desires with His chosen people. He is the groom, humanity His beloved and sought-after bride.

When Israel breaks the covenant, she is likened to an unfaithful spouse. But God promises to take her back, to "espouse" her to Him forever in an everlasting covenant.

The new wine that Jesus gives out at today's feast is the gift of the Holy Spirit given to His bride and body. This is the "salvation" announced to the "families of nations".
