

# PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - Weekdays, after the 8am Morning Mass (approach the priest) First Fridays -8:45am to 9:15am First Saturdays - 9:30am to 10:00am, 3:30pm to 4:00pm (by appointment) Every Sunday - 11:30am to 12:00Noon

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time



Last February 12, we celebrated the Baptism of the LORD, the Gospel according to Luke, we heard this revelation from the Scripture: When all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, and

the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form, as a dove, and a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with You, I am well pleased." This is one of the clearest depictions of the Trinity in the Bible. The Father is speaking from heaven, the Spirit is descending in bodily form like a dove, and Jesus himself is baptized.

Jesus has shown us his intimate fellowship within the Trinity whenever He prayed --- those were moments of unbroken fellowship with the ones who loved him and who he loved. He also taught us that this love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit isn't exclusive to the Trinity. We can call God ABBA, our Father, and we can only do so through the help of the Holy Spirit.

We are all called to have an intimate relationship with God. Our prayers, meditation. and time spent with God draw us closer to the Trinity. For



this reason, we ought to prioritize personal time with God to have an intimate relationship with Meanwhile, in this Sunday's SECOND God. READING, St. Paul reminds us, "For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, enslaved people or free-and all were made to drink of one Spirit." This means a relationship of intimacy, cooperation, and love that is of God must also be in us.

We must ask ourselves, "How can we bring more people closer and belong to this one **Body. the Church?**
