

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

Featured Saint of the Week

The Presentation of the Lord

Originally celebrated in the Eastern Churches as "The Meeting," in the sixth century it began to be celebrated in the West, where the focus became the purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and was accompanied by solemn blessings and processions with candles; hence, it is popularly called "Candlemas." By the offerings of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph and the prophecy of St. Simeon, the life of Christ here begins to point toward his Resurrection.

<u>A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR</u>

Peace and blessings to you my dear brothers and sisters in the Lord!

It has been a year since this pandemic started. It shook our world and showed us that there is no real assurance in this world except God. But it seems that a lot of people are still closing their eyes to this truth. We think that we can survive this pandemic without the intervention of God.

In the Old Testament, whenever the Israelites would turn their back on the Lord and would not listen to Him, calamity would befall them not as a punishment but as a consequence of turning away from God, who is their "shield and protection" from evil.

Let us again bend our knees and recognize our Creator who is a Loving Father to us. In Him is our Life and Salvation.

Let us learn how to be still in front of God, to know him more. For knowing Him is knowing ourselves too. The greatest joy of humanity is to know God!
