The EPIPHANY of the LORD

The **Feast of the Epiphany** celebrates Christ's manifestation to the world --- not only to his chosen people but to all peoples --- represented by the Magi *in the* Gospel **(Matthew 2: 1-12)** and the Ephesians in the Epistle (Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6).

Epiphany means "manifestation" or "appearance," and there are other manifestations of God in the Bible. During this Christmas Season of this liturgical year, our readings at Mass focus on the following:

- At Jesus' Birth, the angels bore witness at the shepherds (representing Israel) bowed and worshiped;
- 2. The visit of the Magi from the East revealed Jesus to the Gentiles. They followed a star to see the newborn baby Jesus in Bethlehem. The Magi brought Jesus gifts: gold considered a symbol of kings; frankincense, a perfume representing divinity; and myrrh, an anointing and embalming oil that symbolized death.

As Catholics, we are encouraged to remember the journey of these wise men, led by a star. We are fellow heirs and adopted children of God who are to follow Jesus and must be guided by our Savior's examples and teachings so that we live, offerings the gift of faithful love until our return to our heavenly Father.
