SAINTHOOD FOR BLESSED KATERI

TEKAKWITHA Pope Benedict XVI advanced the sainthood cause of Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha (1656-1680) by signing the decree recognizing the miracles needed for the canonization. Blessed Kateri, known as the Lily of the Mohawks, was born to a Christian Algonquin mother and a Mohawk father in 1656 in upstate New York along the Hudson River. She was baptized by a Jesuit missionary in 1676 when she was 20, and she died in Canada four years later. In June 1980, she became the first Native American to be beatified.
