

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE of the Church basement hall entrance, toilets and stage. Last December 2022, we had <u>automatic door</u> repaired, the <u>main entrance</u> was repainted, the <u>dropped ceiling installed</u>, <u>ceiling lights</u> are changed using LED lights. The three toilets were upgraded with <u>easy to open doors</u> while the <u>inside walls were repainted</u>. Its total cost is \$12,672.55.

From the PASTOR's 0FFICE

Dear Parishioners and friends at Assumption Parish:

CHRISTMAS SEASON is still here [ending this year on January 9 – Feast of the baptism of the LORD]. We celebrate the EPIPHANY OF THE LORD this Sunday, January 8, 2023.

In our Liturgy, similar to Christmas, we have a Vigil Mass and the Mass of the Day. For Catholics. this solemnity focuses on the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God, and Savior of the world. We celebrate the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. In the magi, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. The magi's coming to Jerusalem to pay homage to the king of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations. Their coming means that pagans can discover Jesus and worship him as the Son of God and Savior of the world only by turning towards the Jews and receiving the messianic promise in the Old Testament. The Epiphany shows that "the full number of the nations" now takes its "place in the family of the patriarchs" and is made "worthy of the heritage of Israel. (cf. CCC 528)

Therefore, today let us focus on the times Jesus manifested to the world who He is and His invitation to all to follow Him. Let us remember that the light of Christ draws all men and women of goodwill to repentance and salvation.

May the Epiphany bring you gifts of wisdom, kindness, and God's grace. I am praying that you have spiritual epiphanies that would lead you to a deeper appreciation of the Catholic Faith.
