

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Saint of the Week

Blessed Junipero Sierra
Born on the island of Mallorca, Spain. Bl. Junipero (1713-1784) entered the Franciscan Order and was ordained a priest. He taught Philosophy and Theology at the University of Padua. At age 37, he went to Mexico City where he spent the rest of his life working for the conversion of the New World. He was responsible for the spread of the Church on the West coast of the United States of America. Bl. Junipero founded nine missions, converting thousands and with his brother Franciscans, founded twelve more.


