

# PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

## **CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

## SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

### **SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -**

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

# A MESSAGE FROM FR. FRANCIS

## Peace be with you!

**Do you seek God's blessings?** If so, take note of these two verses (Deuteronomy 30:8-9): first, "You, who obey the voice of the LORD and observe all his commandments." Second, "The LORD will generously increase your undertakings, the fruit of your womb, the offspring of your livestock, and the produce of your soil; for God will again take delight in your prosperity, just as he took delight in your ancestors."

With the above context, the beginning verse and the whole First Reading today find their full meaning.

**In following the LORD's Will, we receive all blessings** - His sanctifying grace - which he grants to His chosen people and us who received the Sacrament of Baptism.

This gift of sanctifying grace remains with us because **God is faithful**. At times, when we turn away from our creator and the teachings of Jesus Christ, we freely choose to be far from blessings! Yet, even in such a situation, God calls all of us to Himself.

All the Father created according to His image and likeness retain innate goodness despite human weaknesses and sinfulness. Therefore, when we are live our Faith *and return to the Lord with all our hearts and being* (cf. Deuteronomy 30:10), we will overcome our predominant faults and are more robust in our resolve toward faithfulness. Ah yes, we will still find ourselves wanting and failing at times, but when we persist in following the voice of GOD, *which is very near..., already in everyone's hearts* (cf. Deuteronomy 30:14), we will have sincerity of heart and constancy in our love of God and others.

The LORD intends to bless us. We only need to be aware, cooperate with that inner voice, and act on them; then, we will have all the blessings. As a daily reminder, the Blessed Virgin's words at the wedding at Cana are appropriate: "Do whatever he [Jesus] tells you."
