

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Saint of the Week

St. Bonaventure, Bishop and Doctor of the Church ,July 15 Born in Bagnoregio, Italy, St. Bonaventure (1221-1274) Entered the Franciscan Order and lectured at the University of Paris, where he met St. Thomas Aquinas. St. Bonaventure became the Minister General of the Friars Minor and a cardinal. Known as the "Seraphic Doctor", he is considered the greatest exponent of mystical theology in the Middle Ages.

A Message from the Pastor

Peace and all good!

The first reading of the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time, year B, gives us the story of Amos, the prophet who was a shepherd called by God to prophecize to His people. He was called by God to be His voice for the people of Israel.

Paul, in his letter to the Ephesians, reminded them about God choosing His people and making covenant with them from the beginning. The covenant was renewed from generation to generation. Lastly, it was renewed by His Son, Jesus and is given to us every time we celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

The Gospel reminds us of our duty to continue responding to that covenant. All baptized Christians are asked by Jesus to proclaim the Gospel that we received from Him. The Mass concludes with the words "The Mass is ended, Go and proclaim the Gospel by your lives", asking us to be prophets to the world.
