



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

From the Pastor's Office

CANADA DAY (French: Fetê du Canada), called Dominion Day until October 1982, is celebrated every July 1st with outdoor events such as festivals, concerts, parades, fireworks, and the singing of the national anthem, "O Canada," among others.

Most homes are decorated with red and white streamers or red maple leaves, and the Canadian flag is displayed while people would wear patriotic outfits, too.

An essential aspect of the day in history is the commemoration of July 1st, 1867 *British North American Act* uniting Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and the Province of Canada (*modernday Ontario*, *Quebec*, *and Labrador*) into a single country, becoming fully independent in 1982.

AS CATHOLICS, what spiritual importance can we find in Canada Day celebration?

Our Catholic Bishops see Canadians as witnesses of Christ in the country and elsewhere and continue working to influence those in government to act from Christian principles and attitudes.

What in particular? I say, the evident diversity of Canadian society. It is God's blessing that here there is unity in diversity --- not perfect, yet prosperous and beautiful.

To nurture it, all its people must be aware that Canada is a nation of immigrants who came to these lands first inhabited by the First Nations. There must also be a courageous acceptance of the good and the bad things that has happened between the original owners and those who came to share nature's bounty. So that today, we can live with hope as we, followers of Jesus, respect one another's dignity and do our best to fulfill God's intent.
