PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

This Sunday's first reading from the book of Genesis, shows us the God who visits his people. A God who wants to be known intimately by us.

This intimacy was made more visible in Jesus becoming man and living among us.

Abraham, our father in faith teaches us how to welcome God and our neighbour. He was concerned about the well being of his visitor, contrary to the picture we see in the Gospel for today with Martha. Martha was more concerned about herself.

Jesus gently rebuked her, underlying that He did not come to be served but to serve. It is important not to be anxious of a lot of things but to center on what is essential: to listen to our Master and Lord. To spend time with Him.
