

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

Joachim and Anne is an extension of the veneration due the Blessed Virgin Mary as the pinnacle of Creation.

### A Message from the Pastor

Peace and all goodness!

The key word for this Sunday's readings is to "gather". The first reading shows us the loving God who through His holy prophet Jeremiah, rebuked shepherds who instead of gathering and caring for His people, had scattered them. The responsorial psalm presents Jesus as the real good shepherd to which all shepherds should be modelled to.

St. Paul, in his letter to the Ephesians, tells uf that the coming of Jesus, the Good Shepherd, broke the dividing wall and made us one with God and with one another.

In the Gospel, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for His people, for they were like sheep without a Shepherd. St. Mark presents Jesus as the true shepherd that cares for His sheep. Jesus taught them for He saw that they were hungry for the word of God. He fed them with the "food that nourishes". Truly even now, Jesus satisfies those who hunger and thirst for Him, the living bread and water of life.

Let us go to Jesus, the Good Shepherd who gathers and nourishes us.


