

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Saint of the Week

St. Benedict, Abbot

Born in Norcia, Italy and educated in Rome, St. Benedict (480-587) lived a solitary life in mountainous Subiaco for three years. He later organized twelve monasteries where the monks devoted themselves to prayer and work. In the abbey of Monte Cassino, which he founded, he wrote his Rule, which wonderfully combines the Roman genius with the monastic wisdom of Christian East. Pope Paul VI proclaimed him Patron of Europe because of his influence on the formation of Christendom.

A Message from the Pastor

Peace!

Both first reading and the Gospel of this Sunday, the 14th week in Ordinary Time, present to us the hardness of the human heart towards God.

In the first reading, God sent His holy prophet, Ezekiel, to the Israelites who rebelled against God. They were hard of face and obstinate of heart. He sent His prophet to call them back because God cared for them.

In the Gospel, we find the same hardness of heart especially among the people of His native place. They saw the miracles He performed, and heard His powerful message but they shut off their hearts in accepting Him as the Messiah.

Paul in his letter to the Corinthians, gave us a hint on how to be open and be receptive to Jesus. Paul himself accepted his "thorn in the flesh" (humiliation, rejection as a true apostle of Jesus), as a way to be more open to God. His humble and contrite heart opens to God, that is why He was able to see and recognize Jesus as the true Messiah.

Let us learn humility from this great apostle of Christ, Paul.
