

## **PASTORAL CARE**

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**SPIRITUAL COUNSELING -** By appointment.

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

## The Catechism of the Catholic Church - THE EUCHARIST

**CCC 1406** Jesus said: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live forever; ... he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and ... abides in me, and I in him" (*Jn* 6:51, 54, 56).

**CCC 1407** The Eucharist is the heart and the summit of the Church's life, for in it, Christ associates his Church and all her members with his sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving offered once for all on the cross to his Father; by this sacrifice he pours out the graces of salvation on his Body which is the Church.

**CCC 1408** The Eucharistic celebration always includes: the **proclamation** of the Word of God; **thanksgiving** to God the Father for all his benefits, above all the gift of his Son; the **consecration of bread and wine**; and **participation** in the liturgical banquet by receiving the Lord's body and blood. These elements constitute one single act of worship.

**CCC 1415** <u>Anyone who desires to receive Christ</u> in Eucharistic communion must be in the state of <u>grace</u>. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance.

**CCC 1416** <u>Communion with the Body and Blood</u> of Christ increases the communicant's union with the Lord, forgives his venial sins, and preserves <u>him from grave sins</u>. Since receiving this sacrament strengthens the bonds of charity between the communicant and Christ, it also reinforces the unity of the Church as the Mystical Body of Christ.
