Pope Benedict has expressed deep concern about the famine developing in the Sahel region of West Africa due to the lack of rain and the resulting increase in desertification. The United Nations reports that at least one million children are at risk for dying in this region and that climate change adaptation policies are needed to prevent conflict.
