

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

<u>A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOBE</u>

Peace and every good! Happy Father's Day and blessings upon all the fathers.

This Sunday we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. In one sense, by our communion, we are the body of Christ. In another sense, in Holy Communion, it is Eucharist or the Christ. Not long ago, I was distributing Holy Communion when a young father approached the altar carrying a three or four year old boy. When the child asked what it was the father was receiving, he simply replied, "That's God." I was so filled with emotion that I could hardly say "Body of Christ" to the next few parishioners. What a beautiful moment to see a father pass on the faith in such a simple, yet profound way.

Our readings for today also tell the simple truth. From the outset and the Book of Genesis (1st reading), we find Melchizedek, a figure of Christ and the long line of priests who followed Him. In the Gospel, Christ anticipates the sacrament of the Eucharist as He multiplies the five loaves and two fish. Then, Paul's first Letter to the Corinthians (2nd reading) recounts the Last Supper and the institution of the Holy Eucharist. The manna from heaven, that fed the Israelites, has now become the Bread of Life for us Catholic Christians. When we receive Holy Communion today, let us respond heartily, "Amen", that is, "Yes, it is true" or, as the young father declared, "That's God!"
