

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

From the Pastor's Office

Last Sunday, we saw through the Mass readings that those who believe and indeed follow Christ are a priestly kingdom and a holy nation, that God shepherds His people, reconciling us through the death of his Son. We also share in the disciples' mission to be instruments of God to call back lost sheep and bring all people to unity and peace.

The liturgies this weekend (June 24-25) encourage us to continue with this mission given to us with confidence, "not to fear those who kill the body" (GOSPEL) because "the LORD has delivered the life of the needy from the hands of evildoers" (FIRST READING). He is our Lord, "steadfast in his love, he answers our pleading" (RESPONSORIAL PSALM).

Today, the 12th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, our Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall prays and celebrates as we gaze upon the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary (secondary Patron of the Archdiocese). The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies her great purity and <u>total</u> giving of self in love for her Son, <u>accepting her</u> mission from GOD the Father.

The Blessed Virgin Mary is our model; with her example and by the grace of GOD, <u>let us</u> <u>accept GOD's Will</u>. May our hearts be like her --- fully dedicated, we strive to do God's Will in our lives and that of others.
