



PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and you must attend a Baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - First Friday-(during exposition of the Blessed Sacrament), 8:30 am to 9:00 am; First Saturday – 9:30 am to 10:00 am By appointment only; Sundays – 11:30 am to 12:00 Noon, By appointment only.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

The votes were tallied by the Election Committee last Sunday, May 28, 2023 at 4PM. The total number of ballots received were sixty-six. Sixty (60) valid vote, and six (6) invalid votes.

Rev. Paul Beaudoin will also join the Pastoral Council and shall be appointed as the Chairperson of the Liturgy Committee.

The RITE OF COMMISSIONING for all Pastoral Council members will be decided during a meeting on June 18, 2023. As a group, they have the privilege to serve the parish community possibly from 2023 up to 2026.

Soon, the Pastor will conduct a series of consultations among the parish's active volunteers about its **Finance Council membership.** Afterward, according to the provisions of our parish's policies, the Archdiocese Norms, and the Church's Canon Law, additional members of the Finance Council will be appointed considering the revised list of nominees during the recent Pastoral Council selection.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church on the Revelation of God as Trivity:

No. 240 – Jesus revealed that God is Father in an unheard-of sense: he is Father not only in being Creator; he is eternally Father in relation to his only Son, who is eternally Son only in relation to his Father: "No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and any one to whom the Son chooses to reveal him" (Matthew 11-27).

No. 241 – For this reason the apostles confess Jesus to be the Word: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God"; as "the image of the invisible God"; as the "radiance of the glory of God and the very stamp of his nature" (John 1:1; Colossians 1:15; Hebrews 1:3).

No. 243 – Before his Passover, Jesus announced the sending of "another Paraclete" (Advocate), the Holy Spirit. At work since creation, having previously "spoken through the prophets," the Spirit will now be with and in the disciples, to teach them and guide them "into all the truth" (Cf. Gen 1:2; Nicene Creed; Jn 14:17, 26; 16:13). The Holy Spirit is thus revealed as another divine person with Jesus and the Father.

No. 244 – The eternal origin of the Holy Spirit is revealed in his mission in time. The Spirit is sent to the apostles and to the Church both by the Father in the name of the Son, and by the Son in person, once he had returned to the Father (Cf. John 14:26; 15:26; 16:14). The sending of the person of the Spirit after Jesus' glorification (Cf. John 7:39) reveals in its fullness the mystery of the Holy Trinity.

No. 261 – The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. God alone can make it known to us by revealing himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
