

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

St. Ephrem, Deacon & Doctor of the Church (June 9)

Born in Mesopotamia and ordained a deacon of Edessa in what is now Turkey, St. Ephrem (306-373) combated the heresies of his time by writing poems and hymns about the mysteries of Christ and the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was in large part responsible for introducing hymns into liturgical worship.

A Message from Your Pastor

Peace and goodness!

Today, we celebrate the solemnity of the coming of the Holy Spirit on Mary and on the Apostles. This event narrated in the Acts of the Apostles brings us to another two great events: The Creation of Man in the book of Genesis and at the Annunciation of the coming of our Lord to Mary.

When God created Adam, he filled him with the Holy Spirit, He breathed into his nostrils and life was given him. Jesus, who is called the second Adam, sends us the Holy Spirit that we, the Church might have life and that our joy may be complete. The coming of the Holy Spirit then will complete our joy. The first Adam, cutting his ties with God by sin, was not able to transmit the fullness of life because he himself lost it. Jesus, by his obedience, re-connects us to the Father.

When the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary the coming of the Saviour through her, the Holy Spirit hovered over her and she was filled by the Holy Spirit. The same Spirit hovered to her again on Pentecost but it also hovered to the Apostles who became all children of Mary at the foot of the Cross. Today, we see Mary and her Children (members of the Church) being filled by the Holy Spirit.

Let us run to Mary, our mother to be able to experience and receive the completeness of joy through the Holy Spirit, for she is the Spouse and the purest Temple of the Holy Spirit.
