

# PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

**SPIRITUAL COUNSELING** - by appointment.

# SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

**FUNERALS** - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

## A Message from Your Pastor

### Peace and goodness!

As we begin the holy observance of Lent, the Gospel brings us to the account of the temptation of Christ. In order for him to renew and re-create the fallen humanity, he has to undergo the same temptation. Noticeable was the difference between the circumstances: Adam and Eve were in paradise when they were tempted. God provided for everything, were not lacking in anything and everything is in abundance. While for Jesus, he was in the dessert. There was nothing there and he was tempted after fasting for 40 days. In fact, the Gospel account tells us that he was very hungry. Adam fell into temptation and sinned against God, while Jesus is victorious over the temptation.

Formed from the soil of the ground and filled with the breath of God's Spirit, Adam was a son of God, created in His image. Crowned with glory, he was given dominion over the world and the protection of His angels. He was made to worship God—to live not by bread alone but in obedience to every word that comes from the mouth of the Father.

Adam, however, put the Lord his God to the test. He gave in to the serpent's temptation, trying to seize for himself all that God had already promised him. But in His hour of temptation, Jesus prevailed where Adam failed—and drove the devil away.

But the grace won for us by Christ's obedience means that sin is no longer our master. We are no longer slaves of our desires. Following Jesus, we will dominate our desires.

As we begin this season of repentance, we can be confident in His compassion, that He will create in us a new heart. As we do in today's Psalm, we can sing joyfully of our salvation, renewed in His presence.
